DUAL BACHELOR OF SCIENCE WITH A MAJOR IN CHEMISTRY AND MASTER OF SCIENCE IN THE FIELD OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND GREEN CHEMISTRY

The Department of Chemistry offers a dual bachelor of science with a major in chemistry (http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/ chemistry/ba/) and master of science in the field of environmental and green chemistry (http://bulletin.gwu.edu/arts-sciences/ chemistry/environmental-green-chemistry-ms/) degree program. The program allows students to take 6 graduate credits as part of their undergraduate program, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required for the master's degree. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
