

DUAL MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND MASTER OF SCIENCE IN THE FIELD OF BUSINESS ANALYTICS

The School of Business offers a dual master of business administration (MBA) (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/mba/>) and master of science in the field of business analytics (MS) (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/decision-science/ms-business-analytics/>) degree program. 18 credits are shared between the two degrees. 3 credits of MSBA core coursework count toward to MBA core requirements. 9 credits of additional MSBA courses count toward MBA electives. MBA students take business analytics-focused electives as part of their remaining MBA elective requirements to count towards the MSBA electives. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.
