UYGR 1001. Beginning Uyghur I. 3 Credits.

Fundamentals of grammar and pronunciation and development of speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in Uyghur.

UYGR 1002. Beginning Uyghur II. 3 Credits.

Continuation of UYGR 1001. Fundamentals of grammar and pronunciation and development of speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in Uyghur. Prerequisites: UYGR 1001 or departmental permission.

UYGR 2001. Intermediate Uyghur I. 3 Credits.

Further development of speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in Uyghur. Prerequisites: UYGR 1002 or departmental permission.

UYGR 2002. Intermediate Uyghur II. 3 Credits.

Continuation of UYGR 2001. Further development of speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in Uyghur. Prerequisites: UYGR 2001 or departmental permission.

UYGR 6001. Uyghur Language and Translation. 3 Credits.

For graduate students pursuing advanced training in the Uyghur language with a focus on translation. Designed to deepen linguistic proficiency and cultural understanding.
