

DUAL MBA AND MAED&HD IN THE FIELD OF HIGHER EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION

The GW School of Business and Graduate School of Education and Human Development offer a dual master of business administration (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/business/mba/>) (MBA) and master of arts in education and human development in the field of higher education administration (<http://bulletin.gwu.edu/education-human-development/educational-leadership/master-higher-education-administration/#text>) (MAEd&HD) degree program. 18 credits can be shared between the two programs, thereby decreasing the number of credits normally required to earn both degrees. All requirements for both degrees must be fulfilled.

Credit sharing: Up to 18 credits can be shared between degrees.

- 12 credits in MAEd&HD courses can be counted toward MBA degree requirements.
- 6 credits of MBA electives, selected in consultation with the higher education administration advisor, can be counted toward MAEd&HD degree requirements.
