MINOR IN MICROBIOLOGY

ADMISSIONS

To be eligible for admission to the minor in microbiology program, students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and must have completed 8 credits in biological sciences courses (with hands-on labs) and 4 credits in microbiology courses (with hands-on labs). Students also must meet essential function requirements. The biological science and microbiology courses may be part of the students program of study but must be completed with a grade of *C* or above prior to taking the upper-level courses within the minor.

In addition, the following is required prior to clinical rotations (clinical microbiology practicum):

- · Confirmation of essential functions
- Immunization records, including PPD (dated within the past 12 months) and evidence of hepatitis B, MMR, varicella, diphtheria, polio, and tetanus vaccinations
- Current physical examination
- Copy of health insurance
- · Copy of criminal background check
- Copy of drug screening test
